
Portable banner frames

Free-standing

Portability is really about having the ability to install branding or advertising in the most favourable position, giving maximum impact whatever the location.


The tie-bars on the sides secures the 'A' profile and allows this frame to stand on hard surfaces.




Heavy duty frames

Factors you need to know

- Made from anodised aluminum 30mm diameter tube
- Cast aluminium joints for strength with rubber 'O' rings for ease of fitting
- Frame can be anchored with pegs
- Frame becomes tensioned when banner is in place
- Pegs and looped elastic are provided together with carrying bag for ease of storage and transport
- Fits easily into the back of a car
- Frames basically made up of 5ft x 3ft (1.524m x 0.914m) modules. This is flexible to suit different banner sizes
- Maximum recommended banner size 20ft x 4ft (6.10m x 1.2m) or 30ft x 3ft (9.144m x 0.914m)
- 6" or 3" gap all round banner
